

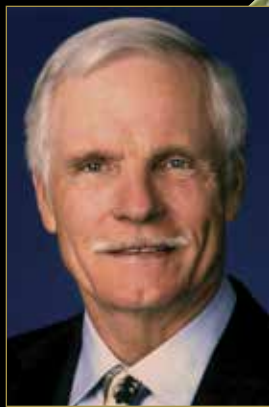

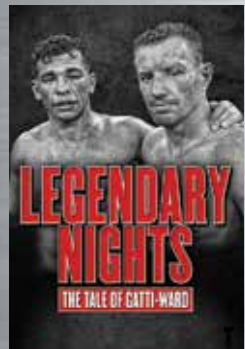
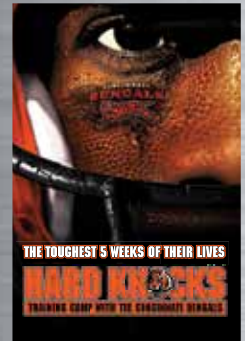

Celebrating the Atlanta Braves 1995 World Series Championship

They all said this young, brash guy from Atlanta was “crazy.”

Ted Turner had to be off-kilter to air Atlanta Braves games across the country on something he dubbed a “Superstation” back in the mid-70s. Who wants to watch that much baseball, especially a team that was floundering back then? Was his grand scheme doomed to fail?

Looking back 40 years later, Turner enjoys yet another in a series of last laughs.

“Sure, people thought I was crazy,” Turner said. “But, I knew it would help our ratings, and I was right. Once the Braves became known as ‘America’s Team,’ my critics stopped calling me ‘crazy.’”

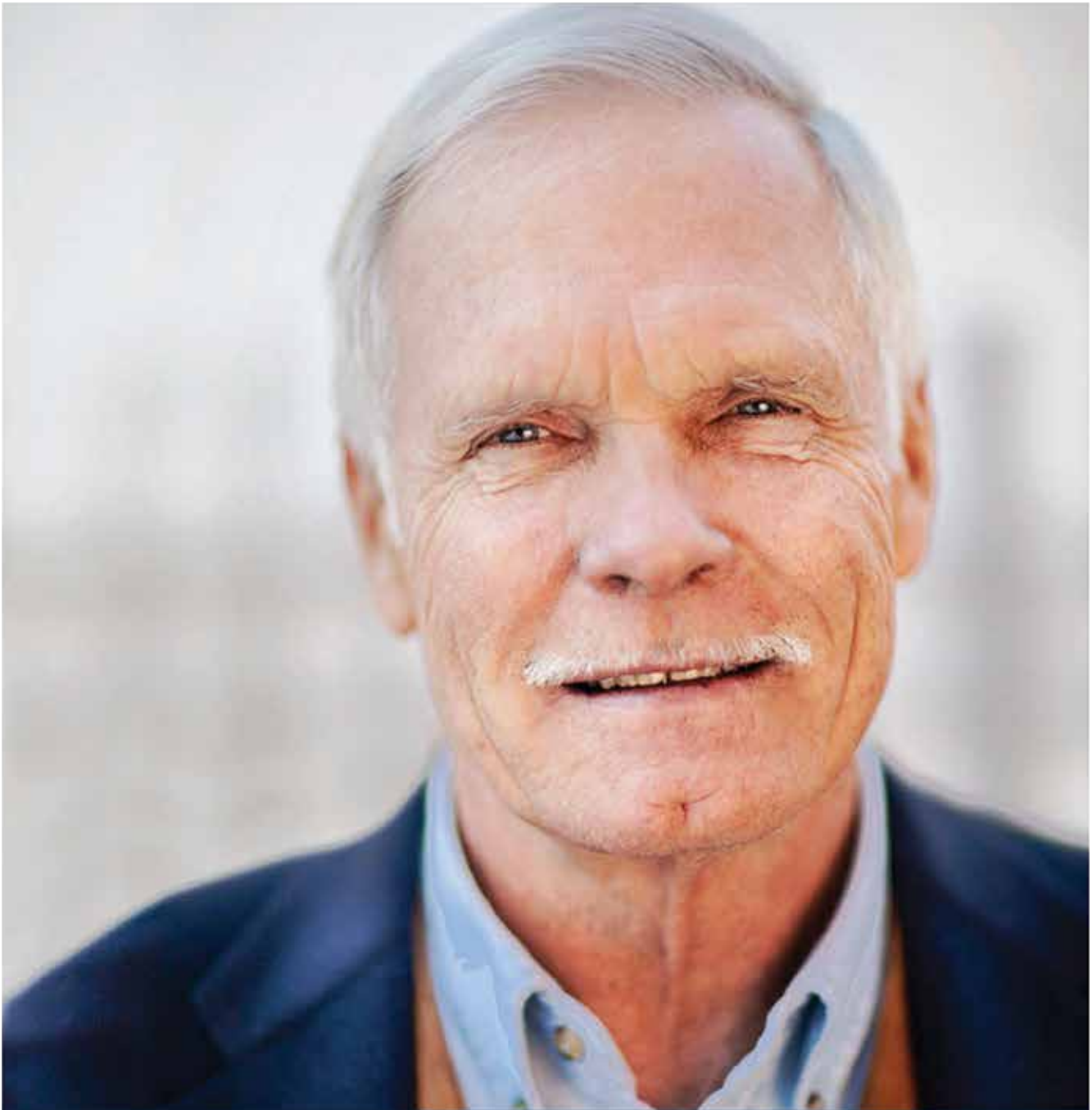
Turner has long since been hailed as a visionary for

changing the landscape of sports television. His move in airing Atlanta baseball and basketball games on WTBS was a forerunner for ESPN and other sports cable networks, national and local, serving fans a 24/7 menu of games, sports news, talk and analysis.

Turner’s impact makes him the worthy recipient of this year’s Lifetime Achievement Award from the National Academy of Television Arts and Sciences. In the announcement, NATAS chairman Malachy Wienges said, “The world of sports and news television has been forever changed by the vision of this one man.”

Indeed, when Turner’s name was mentioned, CBS Chairman Sean McManus, who served on the selection committee, was among those who assumed he already had

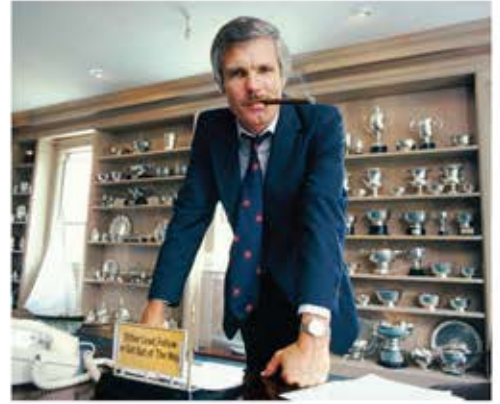

Left to right: Some of the many faces of Ted Turner

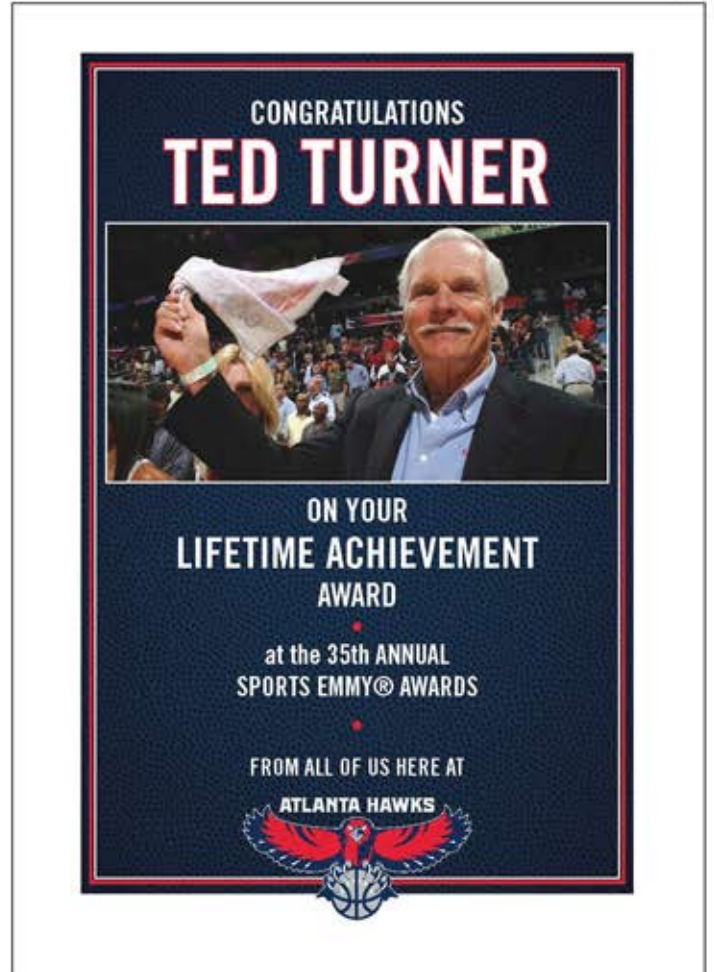
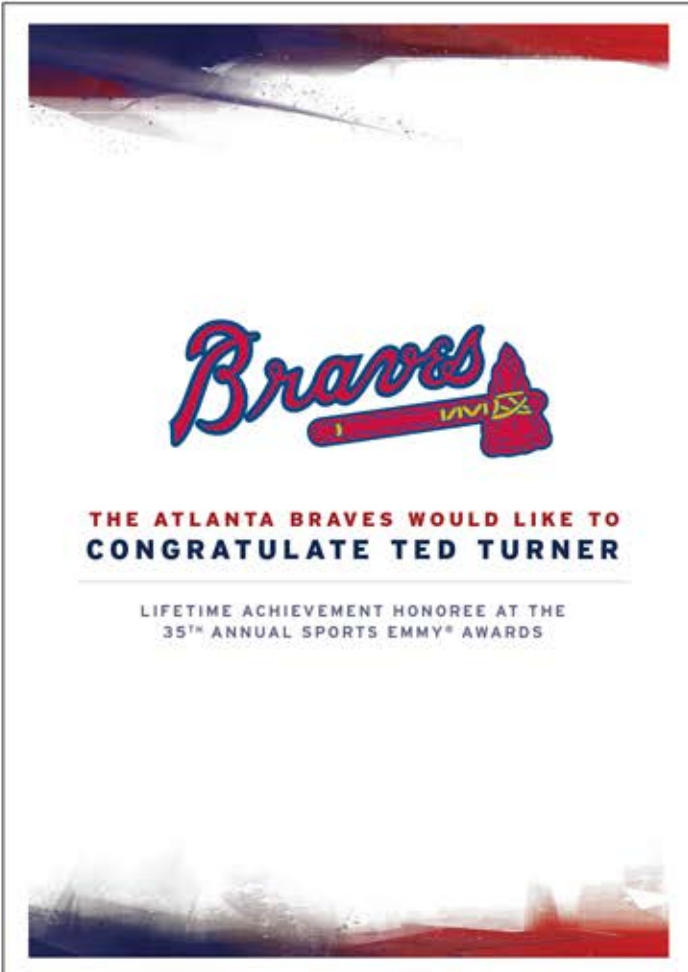
been bestowed the Lifetime honor.

“The initial thought we had was, ‘Why didn’t we think of this before?’” McManus said. “When his name was brought up, it was instantaneous, of course. Look at what he’s done in the world of sports. It was a no brainer.”

McManus then added, “Ted Turner is the kind of person for whom Lifetime Achievement awards are created.”

David Levy, the president of Turner Sports, knows what Turner has meant to him and his network. Turner Sports now is a major player in sports TV, with packages that include the NBA, Major League Baseball, the PGA Championship and the NCAA Basketball Tournament. In April, the network experienced a landmark moment by airing the semifinal games during Saturday of the Final Four for the first time. In

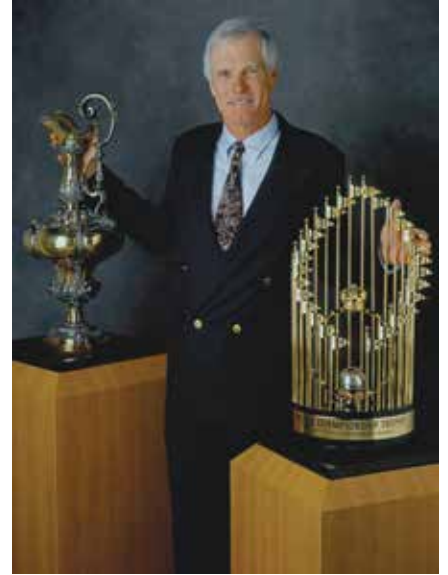
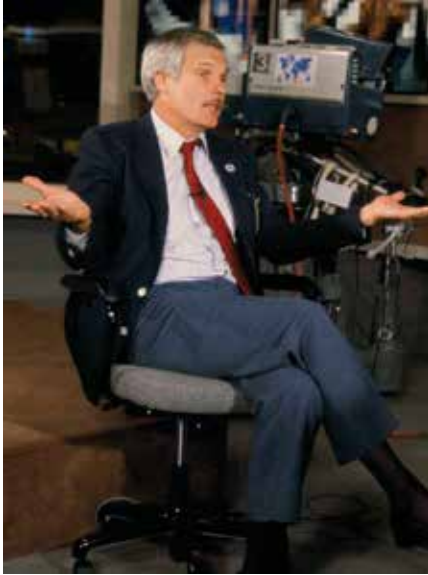

2016, Turner will air the championship game.

“This guy is a true visionary,” Levy said. “He said, ‘Content is king’ before anyone else said content is king. He realized sports were a huge part of that content. He really understood

the business better than anyone else.”

Turner’s TV ride began when he purchased a struggling UHF station in Atlanta in 1970. Looking for programming, WTCG (which stood for “Watch This Channel Grow”)

started to air Atlanta Braves games in 1974. After the Braves sunk to a 67-94 record in 1975 and drew only 534,672 fans, prompting speculation the team could move to Toronto, Turner stepped in and bought the franchise. He also added the Atlanta Hawks to his portfolio the following year.

They were purely TV deals for Turner.

“We needed viewers, and Atlanta sports teams came with built-in audiences,” Turner said. “Fans wanted to see the Braves play, and were willing to buy UHF antennas if necessary. Once they had the antennas, we knew that people would watch not only the Braves, but our other programming as well.”

Added Levy: “He owned the teams not for the vanity of owning a team. He realized (the games) are a lot of content in primetime.”

Turner’s next move then was to rename the station WTBS and link it to satellite. This allowed early cable operators to gain access to his “Superstation” for a small fee.

Now, the Braves were going coast-to-coast. Initially, even Turner admits he might have underestimated the impact of their games across the country

“The Atlanta Braves were initially a losing team, so I really didn’t see airing their games outside of the Atlanta market as a threat to other franchises,” Turner said. “But, I was wrong. A lot of people didn’t like the idea, but it proved to really pay off for us by increasing ratings and the Braves’ fan base.”

TBS helped the Braves solidify their place as “America’s Team.” In 1982, they won the National League West pennant. Attendance more than tripled to 1.8 million. And TBS was reaching 25 million homes, up from 700,000 six years before.

Ernie Johnson Jr. literally had a first-hand look on the Superstation’s impact on the Braves and TV sports. His father, Ernie Johnson Sr., was the long-time Braves’ play-by-play voice for Turner.

“My dad started getting letters from all over the country,” Johnson said. “People were listening to him everywhere. It

Ted Turner changed my life in more ways than one. I had interviewed him quite a few times on my shows out of Miami and Washington and when an opening occurred at CNN for 9 o’clock, he called me. Wanted an answer immediately, which is Ted’s way. We gave him an answer the next day. I rolled the dice. He said if you are unhappy after one year, you can leave the show. Well, the first night I went on, I knew it would work. The Larry King Live show became a 26 year entity. The longest running show to be hosted by the same person, at the same hour, on the same network. Ted is the greatest person I’ve ever worked for. One, he never bothered you. Two, he stood by you. Three, he is the most loyal person in the world. I almost left him once, which would have been a big error on my part. He called me on the phone and said “..you can’t leave. You can’t leave,” and I couldn’t.

I visited his ranches in Montana and New Mexico. I had a delightful time and he taught me how to fly fish.

I think he is the greatest media figure in the second half of the 20th century. What he did with CNN, and his worldwide ventures, what he has done for charity, what he has done for the fields of baseball and sailing cannot be measured in words

He is a true renaissance man. He’s one of the most honorable figures that you or I will ever meet. I consider it a joy to have been in his company, to have been his employee, to be his friend.

There are too many adjectives to explain Ted Turner. Let’s put it simply this way. There is only one Ted Turner. There will never be another Ted Turner. He is who he is, an American masterpiece.

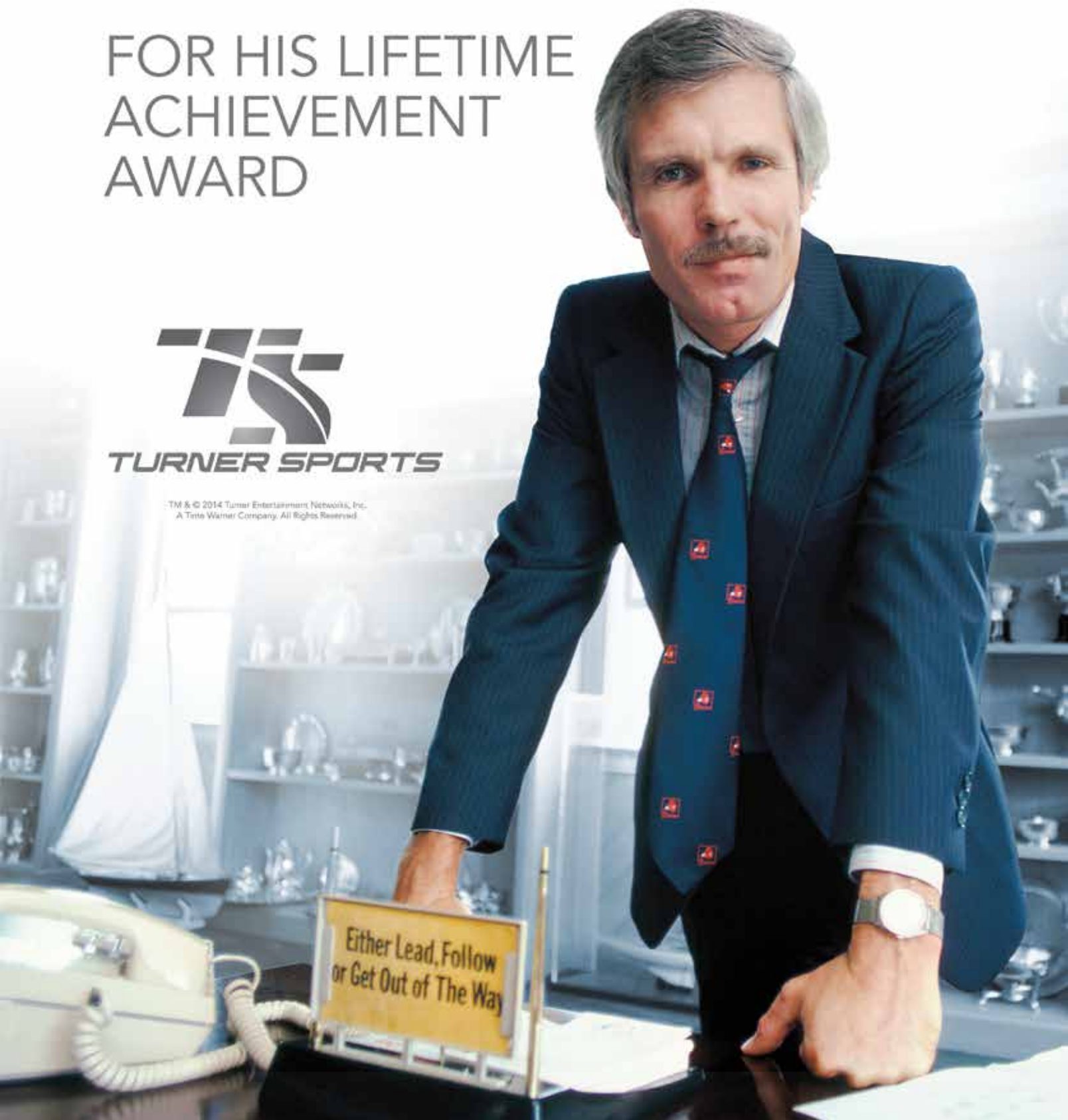

showed you the scope of this Superstation.”

Johnson, now one of the pillars of Turner Sports in his various roles, recalled his father had a close relationship with Turner. They never had more than a handshake deal.

“Ted used to say, ‘You don’t need a contract as long as I’m around here,’” Johnson said. “Dad really loved working for him. He would come home and say, ‘You should hear what Ted said today.’ That tradition goes back a long, long way.”

Johnson believes Turner was always driven by “naysayers,” whether it was with the Superstation or the launch of CNN. Tell him something couldn’t be done, Johnson said, and Turner wanted to do it that much more.

“He was a true pioneer in sports,” Johnson said. “He set the path for everybody. He said, ‘Yeah, this will work. And not only will it work, but you’ll be doing it too.’”

Indeed, the notion that viewers would consume sports on a daily basis beyond their local teams helped fuel the formation of ESPN in 1979 and all that followed in the new cable era. Looking back four decades later, it is easy to see how the concept made sense.

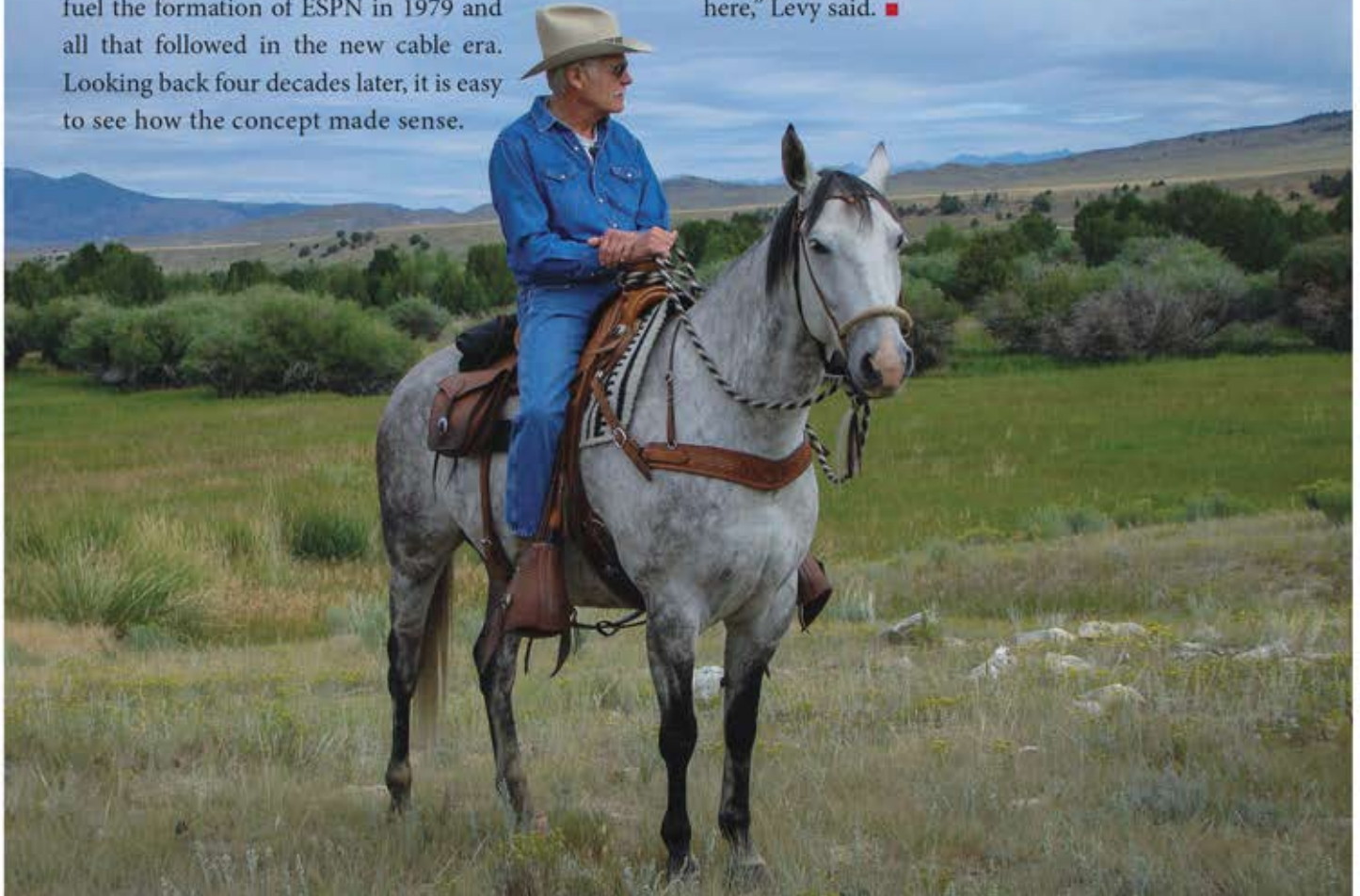
“It definitely paved the way for ESPN and similar networks because the idea of being able to watch and follow teams of your choosing, regardless of geography, was now possible,” Turner said. “People enjoy having a choice in entertainment – whether it be news, sports or other programming.”

Turner is no longer active in the operations of Turner Sports. However, he is extremely proud of how the network has grown as a force in sports television. When Turner and CBS combined to sign a landmark 14-year, \$10.8 billion for the NCAA tournament in 2010, Levy received countless letters of congratulations. He saved one of them: A note from Turner.

“It’s incredible how far Turner Sports has come over the years, and it’s grown even more in recent years,” Turner said. “Turner Sports has proven itself as a major player, and it gives me great pride to have started it.”

The pride goes both ways.

“From my perspective, I’m proud to be able to continue the tradition of the name that’s on the door here,” Levy said. ■

The Next Phase in Sports TV

On Final Four Saturday, many viewers were surprised at what they were hearing when they tuned into the semifinal games. Did Rex Chapman really say “we” during analysis of the Kentucky game? Why is Wayne Larrivee openly rooting for Wisconsin? Those guys doing the Florida game don’t sound impartial.

What happened to objectivity on the network telecast? And by the way, who kidnapped Jim Nantz?

The confusion was inevitable and hardly unexpected. Sure enough, Nantz, along with Greg Anthony and Steve Kerr, handled the calls of those games for TBS.

However, if viewers went to TNT or truTV, they heard special “Teamcast” calls of the semifinal games. They were specially tailored telecasts geared to the individual teams, with separate announcers, analysts, on-court reporters and halftime shows.

CBS and Turner Sports, partners in coverage of the NCAA tournament, tried to spread the word about the new set-up for Final Four Saturday. CBS Sports chairman Sean McManus, though, knew not everyone would get the message.

“We have to figure out a way to remind people that these are separate telecasts,” McManus said. “I can see Twitter lighting up. ‘Why are they rooting for (that team)?’ For years, all those people who wrote that (the announcers) are rooting for a specific team, well, now they can say that legitimately.”

Welcome to the next phase in sports TV. The days of one game, one channel could be coming to an end. At least for the biggest games.

Turner Sports’ “Teamcast” coverage came on the heels of ESPN’s “Megacast” format for the Florida State-Auburn BCS title game in January. ESPN spread its coverage over four of its TV platforms, in addition to using several more on its website. One channel featured current coaches in a film-room set-up analyzing the game from different camera angles than the

national telecast. ESPN Classic simply aired video with just crowd noise, no announcers.

Meanwhile, in golf, subscribers to DirecTV continue to receive bonus coverage of the majors and select tournaments with several additional channels featuring players and holes beyond what airs on the networks. The same dynamic exists for the Golf Channel with what it bills as “Spotlight” coverage for select events on weekends.

Previously, the networks have tried to push viewers into using their computers as second screens with special coverage of games. Now they are looking to take advantage of their various platforms in the cable universe. The concept is simple: Multiple channels are better than one.

“We want to continue to stretch ourselves to be different and unique,” said Turner Sports president David Levy of “Teamcast.” “The concept was born out of the popularity of the NCAA tournament and the incredible passion fans have for their schools. Internally, we said, ‘What can we do that’s different?’ We wanted to provide alternate views.”

Ed Placey, the senior coordinating producer of ESPN’s college football coverage, said the decision to go with the “Megacast” for the BCS title game had been under consideration for a long time.

“We’ve been working on and tinkering with multi-screen coverage approaches for many years, such as the various Full Circle events we did in 2006,” Placey said “We’ve continued these concepts with second platform versions of games on Longhorn Network and ESPNU. Those left us wanting to do more, fine-tune the approaches and try new ones.”

The multi-channel approach is a massive undertaking for what is already a huge challenge by simply airing a game on one

network. Levy said three different production trucks were used for "Teamcast."

"When you push yourself, sometimes it comes with expense," Levy said.

ESPN's "Megacast" featured eight production trucks, 63 cameras and 72 microphones. Placey said all the moving parts required considerable coordination. He noted ESPN had full-time isolated shots of both coaches serving six of the networks simultaneously.

"It's been a tremendous process because it's explorative and collaborative in ways that only a few projects allow us on this scale," Placey said. "So many different departments have jumped in on this because of the opportunity to do things in ways they've not been done before. It's energizing. The more enjoyable challenges are finding the best ways to maximize every resource."

The multi-platform approach makes the most sense for coverage of golf. Unlike the other sports, the action is spread out throughout 18 holes on a course. Some holes merit continuous coverage in their own right. The devilish par 3 12th at Augusta National and the island hole at TPC Sawgrass have doomed the fates of many golfers at the Masters and Players Championship, while nothing on the PGA Tour compares to the wild antics of the 16th hole of the Waste Management Phoenix Open. The Golf Channel used eight cameras to capture the emotions of the huge crowds of the famed par 3 in the desert.

Golf Channel president Mike McCarley said "Spotlight" is an innovative way to bring more people into golf telecasts.

"Spotlight" has proven to be a coup for golf fans looking to get further inside the ropes at signature stretches of tournament venues," McCarley said.

Indeed, ESPN's Placey believes the multi-platform presentation introduces viewers to new windows to a sports telecast. In a day and age when people have short attention spans, presenting them with more options is a way to keep them tuned in.

"It will open them up to new ways of experiencing a game and provide an opportunity to sample new possibilities for how they consume a big event that might not have occurred to them," Placey said. "This allows us to appeal to different tastes and to niche audiences who like non-traditional productions.

Since its beginnings, TV has taught audiences how to view sporting events in different ways and that view has constantly evolved over the years."

Placey, though, cautioned there's always an adjustment with change.

"The very first replays took some getting used to," Placey said. "The first full-time mini-board, the first virtual first down marker, the first full-time bottom line... As viewers acclimated to new viewing experiences, they learned how to watch in new ways."

Placey was right. Viewers liked some elements of ESPN's "Megacast" coverage and disliked others. Placey said the network monitored viewer reaction for "Megacasts" in the future.

McManus and Levy still are analyzing the reaction to the "Teamcast" format for Final Four Saturday. Reviews were generally good, but there were some detractors.

"We knew there would be positive and negatives, but that's part of the event," Levy said.

When asked about the future of the multi-platform approach for CBS' coverage of big events like the Super Bowl, McManus left all his options open.

"It's a good question," McManus said. "We need to get more answers. Having said that, we're always looking to be more innovative. Anything is possible." ■

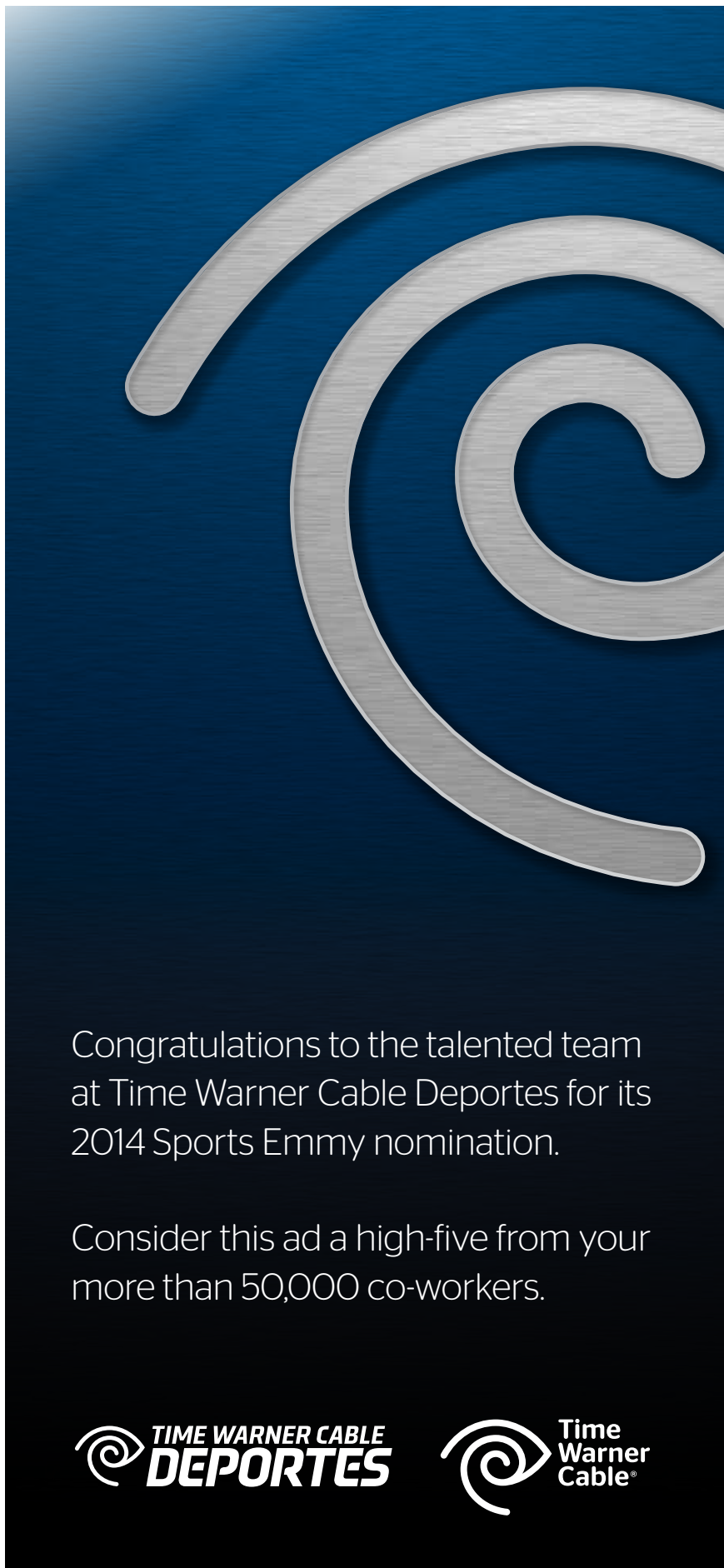

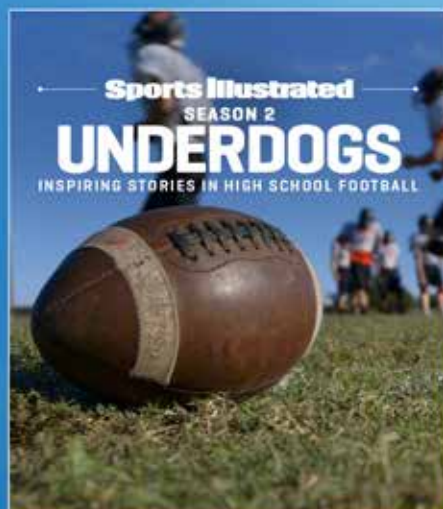
